Scholarship Details:

(2) \$500 or (1) \$1,000 will be given to one to two individuals based on the following –

- Graduating Senior for Ogden High School with a GPA of 3.0 or above
- Post secondary education is not mandatory for scholarship application - students may be going into the workforce straight from school, trade school, and/or continuing their education.
- A check will be written out to the receiving awardee and handed out at class night

- Include one letter of recommendation
- Submit application to Ogden High School guidance counselor by April 17th
